

Eligibility Criteria for B.A. Honours Programme 2019-20	
Subjects	Eligibility Criteria
1. ECONOMICS	Students passed in HS examination in Arts, Science and Commerce with an aggregate of 45% marks (without grace mark) may apply for Honours Programme in Economics. Mathematics at 10+2 level is preferable.
	Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination.
2. ASSAMESE	Students passed in HS examination in Arts, Science and Commerce with Assamese as subject and an aggregate of 45% marks (without grace mark) may apply for Honours Programme in Assamese. Advance Assamese at 10+2 level is preferable
	Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in Assamese and English at 10+2 Examination Plus additional 5% of marks shall be added to the total for Advance Assamese if the subject is offered at 10+2 examination.
3. GEOGRAPHY	Students passed in HS examination with Geography as subject and an aggregate of 45% marks (without grace mark) may apply for Honours Programme in Geography.
	Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in Geography and English only at 10+2 Examination.
4. POLITICAL SCIENCE	50% in English and 60% in Political Science with an aggregate of 60% in the 10+2 Examination may appear in the Selection Test for Honours in Political Science..
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in Selection Test and the total marks obtained in the 10+2 Examination.
5. ENGLISH	65% in aggregate and 70% in English in the 10+2 Examination to appear in the Selection Test which will be notified by the Department.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of a) Marks secured in Selection Test, Plus b) Bonus marks from the aggregate and c) Bonus marks from English in 10+2 Exam.
6. PHILOSOPHY	55% in aggregate, 40% in English and 50% in Logic and Philosophy in the 10+2 Examination.
	Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the total marks secured in 10+2 Examination Plus marks secured in Logic and Philosophy .
7. HINDI	40% in Hindi with an aggregate of 40% in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination
8. HISTORY	45% in History , 40% in English with an aggregate of 45% in 10+2 Examination.
	Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination
9. SANSKRIT	40% in aggregate. Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination.

10. SOCIOLOGY	45% in Sociology and 40% in English in 10+2 Examination. Merit List will be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in 10+2 Examination
