2. How will study what?

Students can select Multidisciplinary Course as per the instruction given below. But students are **not allowed** to select a subject if the students (i) is studying the subject as Major and (ii) had studied that subject in 10+2 level.

- Students from **Arts** will study a course from **Social Science and Humanities**
- Students from **Commerce** will study a course from **Natural Science**
- Students from **Science** will study a course from **Com., Statistics and Comp. Sc.**
